GENERAL CLUB QUESTIONS

- **What does Talamore mean?**

The name Talamore is Gaelic for 'land of great value'.

- **What does Applecross mean?**

The origin of the Applecross name comes from a peninsula off the West Coast of Scotland. This area, known for its peaceful landscape is a reflection of the pristine rolling hills of East Brandywine. The 840 acres that comprise Applecross follows this heritage and will be transformed into an elegant golf course community that boasts beautiful homes, charming neighborhoods, stunning views, and a premier country club.

- **What makes Talamore and Applecross so unique and different compared to other area courses and Clubs?**

The most unique aspect of the Talamore – Applecross Clubs is our unique Multi-Club Membership. Because Applecross and Talamore have similar ownership interests we are able to offer Chester County and Montgomery County the first and only Multi-Club Membership opportunity. Members at Talamore and Applecross have 100% reciprocity with each club based on their category of Membership selected.*

World class golf and Club facilities grace each of the properties that are part of The Talamore Family of Clubs. Legendary golf designers including Nicklaus, Palmer and Jones have each put their stamp on the Talamore courses. GOLF COURSES

Talamore Country Club

Talamore Country Club in Ambler features 18 exciting holes designed in the low country feel of the Carolinas. Wetlands or water grace 16 of the 18 holes and 4 sets of tees provide golfers of all abilities a fun and unique challenge. Talamore was named as one of the top 25 courses in the state and also one of the top new courses in the country when it opened in 1995. "Rave Reviews" and "Must Experience" have graced the headlines for this truly one of a kind gem in the heart of Montgomery County.

 **Applecross Country Club**

Applecross Country Club is the first Nicklaus Design golf course in the Philadelphia area. It's classic blend of old world charm as it weaves through the countryside is blended with modern shaping and shot making design. Golf facilities include 18 holes of Championship Golf, our new 19th hole, a full length professional driving range and other related practice facilities. The Golf Course is currently under construction and is projected to open in the Summer of 2010. The design goal of the course is to create an exciting, challenging and most of all fun golf experience for golfers of all skill levels. The rolling terrain, manicured fairways, native wetlands and timeless Chester County countryside will combine for a golfing experience unique to the surrounding area.

 **Talamore Country Club**

Talamore has the area's most comprehensive practice facilities featuring a lushly landscaped driving range with 5 bunkered target greens at varied distances, 3 practice putting and chipping greens adjacent to the Clubhouse and our state of the art Short Game Center which features 4 full size practice greens which simulate every imaginable shot from 80 yards in.

 **Applecross Country Club**

Applecross features a state-of-the-art driving range with multiple target greens. A practice green is available for putting and chipping. A new state-of-the-art indoor/outdoor teaching center and 19th hole is opening Spring/Summer 2011.

 **Talamore Resort and Mid South Club**

The Talamore Golf Resort features 2 full length driving ranges, multiple practice and chipping greens. Our Mid South Club is also famous for its 19th hole, a full length par 3 adjacent to the clubhouse where all ties are broken!

FITNESS, POOLS AND TENNIS

 **Talamore Country Club**

Talamore offers a resort style swimming pool w/ Jacuzzi and kiddie pool open from Memorial Day to Labor Day, State of the Art fitness center w/ 2 active personal trainers, 4 dining areas (2 indoor & 2 outdoor) and 2 Hard Tru Tennis courts.

 **Applecross Country Club**

The Grove Amenities at Applecross include a fully equipped Fitness Center, exercise rooms, indoor pool and Jacuzzi open year round, outdoor pool open from Memorial Day to Labor Day, Lighted Tennis courts and the Grove Clubhouse featuring a timeless blend of country architecture and modern amenities. Part of the Grove Clubhouse will be used for home sales by the primary developer until the community has been fully developed. Miles of walking trails weave throughout the Applecross property and Brandywine countryside.

CLUBHOUSES



Talamore Country Club

Talamore features a turn of the century clubhouse which is a converted stable for the former Governor’s mansion located next door. More than 30,000 square feet of Member Dining, Banquet and outdoor dining facilities all decorated with the old world charm.

Temporary Golf Clubhouse

Prior to the completion of the permanent golf clubhouse, the Club is providing temporary golf facilities which will include a Pro Shop, Mixed Grill & Bar and Men’s and Ladies Locker facilities. A covered patio overlooking the 18th hole with outdoor grilling and food service facilities is also available.

Permanent Golf Clubhouse

Currently in the preliminary design phase, the Applecross Golf Clubhouse will overlook the 18th hole and feature a full service Pro Shop and Men’s and Ladies Locker Rooms. The permanent Golf Clubhouse is projected to start when the Applecross community has conveyed 500 homes.

Currently in the design phase is the Member Dining facilities & program which will accompany the permanent golf clubhouse overlooking 18th hole. The Dining program will feature a non smoking dining area, mixed grill and bar and an outdoor covered dining patio. Prior to the completion of the permanent Member Dining facilities, the Club will use the temporary golf clubhouse and patio, the Grove Clubhouse, outdoor pool area and the covered patio overlooking the 18th hole for Member social gatherings and functions.



Talamore Resort and Mid South Club

The Talamore Golf Resort has 2 clubhouses, one at the resort and one at the Mid South Club. A mixed grille, covered and open air patios and the famous Members only “Crows nest” at the Mid South Club all await our Members and their guests. Decorated with classic southern charm, each of the clubhouses are comfortable and inviting.

- *How many homes are in the Talamore and Applecross communities and are they affiliated with the Club?*



Talamore Country Club

Talamore CC has 390 homes in the community and is fully complete. Every Homeowner is a Social Member of the Club with privileges that include use of the pool, tennis and fitness center and Social Member dining areas. Resident Social Membership also allows for access to the Talamore Golf Course 6 times annually with the payment of a cart fee. Holiday and weekend tee time restrictions apply.



Applecross Country Club

There are approximately 900 homes ultimately planned for the community of Applecross. Every homeowner is a Sports Member of the Club. Sports Membership allows for unlimited use of the Fitness Center and other Grove Area Amenities. Sports Membership also allows for access to the Applecross Golf Course 6 times annually with the payment of a greens fee/cart fee. Holiday and weekend tee time restrictions apply.



Talamore Resort and Mid South Club

The Talamore Golf Resort and Mid South Club are both residential golf communities with a combined master Plan of approximately 1,000 homes ranging from single family estate homes to patio homes and condominiums. The Talamore and Mid South communities combined will have approximately 75% permanent owners and 25% second home owners. At present approximately 50% of the planned units have been completed/sold.

- ***Who is building the homes at the various Talamore communities?***



Talamore Country Club

The homes at Talamore Country Club were built by Realen Homes and Guidi homes, 2 prominent area home-builders from 1994-1999.



Applecross Country Club

Pulte Homes (NYSE: PHM) is one the nation's largest homebuilders. Pulte is the Master Developer at Applecross and is building all the homes. Pulte is credited for the vision of the Applecross Club/community including the golf course layout, home designs, Grove Area Amenities and general clubhouse area. Talamore Resort and Mid South Club

The Talamore Golf Resort is being developed in part by a wholly owned development subsidiary and by other local /regional builders. There are currently 6 different builders providing a range of home packages along with the primary developer that is offering building lots.

- ***What reciprocal privileges are available with the Talamore Golf resort and Mid South Club in Pinehurst, NC?***

Additional reciprocal Membership privileges are available at the Talamore Golf Resort in Pinehurst, North Carolina. The Resort features 2 world class golf courses designed by Rees Jones and Arnold Palmer. There are multiple on site lodging options including spacious Villas and our new luxurious Lodge. Walking trails, tennis and 2 pools are also part of the Resort. Talamore Country Club and Applecross Members have seasonal reciprocal privileges regarding use of the Resort. See your Membership Director for details.

- ***Is Talamore and Applecross an equity or non-equity club and what is the difference between an equity club and a non equity club?***

Talamore and Applecross are corporate owned non-equity clubs. An equity club is owned by the Members. Members are therefore assessed for all capital improvements and revenue shortfalls. A non equity club is typically owned by a corporation. Members are typically not assessed for capital improvements and/or revenue shortfalls at a non equity club.

- ***Are there Assessments?***

No. Unlike other equity Clubs, Talamore and Applecross do not assess their Members.

- ***How do you sign up for Membership?***

Our Membership Director can walk you through the details and application for Membership.

- ***Are there monthly food minimums?***

Talamore Country Club requires annual expenditures for food and beverage from each of its Non-Resident Social Members and Full Golf Members.

Applecross Full Golf and Non-Resident Social Members will be required to maintain annual food and beverage expenditures when permanent clubhouse facilities are provided. Until such time, no food and beverage minimums will be required.

Talamore Golf Resort does not require food and beverage minimums.

- ***What type of Member events are planned for Social & Golf Members?***

Talamore and Applecross feature an active Social calendar with Wine dinners, Surf & Turf Night, a Luau, Halloween party, Brunch with Santa, and special themed buffets for Thanksgiving, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Pumpkin painting, Scarecrow Stuffing, Chili Cook offs & more!

- ***What are the available dining options?***

 **Talamore Country Club**

Talamore offers 2 year round dining options. Findlay's is a non smoking pub which has a bar, booths and other comfortable seating and is available for all Members. McKean's Grille is reserved for Full Members and allows cigar and cigarette smoking. Findlay's and the McKean's Grille are open year round. On a seasonal basis, Talamore has al fresco options which include the Oak Patio, poolside tables and Club 19. Our full menu is available on the Oak Patio and a sandwich menu is available poolside and at Club 19.

Talamore Country Club offers a diverse menu which has a host of appetizers, entrée salads, sandwiches and entrees. On Sundays we feature a special brunch menu alongside our regular menu. Menus are changed twice a year.

Currently in the final approval process is a comprehensive expansion and renovation of the Club's Member Dining facilities to include a new non-smoking bar area and separate areas for family-friendly dining and casual dining.

 **Applecross Country Club**

Until the permanent Golf & Dining clubhouse is complete, the Club will utilize the Grove Clubhouse and outdoor pool area for regular food and beverage events. The poolside snack bar will be available during the summer months for snacks. The temporary golf clubhouse features a mixed grille and outdoor dining patio.

  **Talamore Resort and Mid South Club**

The Talamore Golf Resort and Mid South Club have golf related food and beverage facilities with a mix of snacks and sandwiches. Our Members enjoy a slate of catered social events including our renowned "Guest Chef Night" held monthly featuring the area's top chefs. Resort guests have a long list of excellent local restaurants to choose from, all just minutes from the resort. These restaurants include the Ironwood Grille, Bonefish, Outback, Beef-eaters, Lobster, Elliott's, Ashtens, Lone Star, Tripps, Chilis, Magnolia Inn and TenYa.

- ***Before signing up for Membership, can I 'test drive' the golf course and Club facilities?***

Yes. Our Clubs have "Preview Day" programs whereby you and your family can play the golf course and/or use the Club's amenities and dining facilities. Member for a day privileges are arranged through our Membership Director or Pro Shop. Member for a day programs do require a fee, yet that fee is credited towards your first year dues should you elect to join the Club as a Full Golf Member or Social Member.

- ***What do Activity Fees cover?***

Activity Fees are paid by each Member and are used to subsidize golf and social events in the form of extra food and beverage and special entertainment.

- ***Is there an Initiation Fee, Bond or other upfront fee required to join the Club?***

Non-Resident Social Memberships require an Initiation Fee. Full Golf Memberships require a Membership Deposit which may be fully refundable per Club guidelines and based on the payment plan selected.

- ***Is my Membership transferable?***

Resident based Memberships are transferable to subsequent homeowners within the community with the payment of a transfer fee. Non Resident Social & Golf Memberships are not transferable.

- ***Is there a committee of Members which meets with Club management?***

Yes. Talamore and Applecross in many ways operate much like an equity Club with several Member committees including a Social Committee, Golf Committee, Membership Committee, Golf Handicap Committee, Greens Committee and Advisory Board. Each Committee meets with Club management on a periodic basis to provide Member feedback, plan events and in general help 'steer' the Club.

- ***Does the Club limit the number of Members?***

Yes. The number of Members in each category is limited based on the capacity of the facilities as judged by the Club. The Club offers multiple levels of Membership to give it the flexibility of better managing peak tee time and other facility usage periods.

- ***How does the Club communicate with the Members regarding Club events and Club news?***

The Talamore Family of Clubs use email extensively to inform the Membership, and Members are required to provide a current email address for such purposes. Members will also receive a periodic newsletter containing information about events and activities at the Club and other items of interest. Members will be able to access club information through the Club's proprietary member page located at www.talamorefamily.com that will provide Members with access to important up to date club information and also allows online tee time reservations. Flyers and other notices are also placed in various spots around the Club

- ***Are there special events or programs for kids?***

All year long. The Club has specific kids themed special events for Halloween, Easter Egg Hunt, Brunch with Santa, and holiday activities at the pool including moon bounce, face painting, balloon experts and more.

- ***What is a POE?***

POE stands for Positively Outrageous Event. These are events held at the Club which are, quite simply, Positively Outrageous because of what the Club offers. Our annual Luau is the most popular outrageous event we offer.

- ***What is Management Philosophy that will guides Talamore and Applecross?***

We have a simple approach:

- We are as hands on as you can get
- We combine professional courtesies and service with a 'mom and pop' business approach
- We strive for as little bureaucracy as is necessary so our Department Managers are empowered to make decisions and do the right thing for our Members.
- We are not infallible and do make mistakes – our goal is to use our mistakes as a learning experience to grow and improve. If we didn't make mistakes that only means we need to work harder and push the envelope further to provide new and different ways of providing service to our Members.

Our Management philosophy is manifest by our employment history. Our key managers have 10+ years with our organization with some managers and employees having roots all the way back to our inception in the early 90's. Our employees are also the friendliest around.

**Reciprocal privileges for each category of Membership are subject to the Club's Rules and Regulations. Terms of reciprocity including tee time access, number of rounds annually, number of reciprocal rounds allowed at peak times, fees etc, are subject to change if required to preserve unfettered tee time access of 'home course' Members.*

GOLF MEMBERSHIP QUESTIONS

• **What types of Golf Memberships are offered?**

Talamore Country Club & Applecross Country Club offer several categories of full golf and limited golf Memberships. The following is a brief overview of the Golf Membership plans

Full Golf Memberships

All Full golf Memberships allow for unlimited use of the course without the payment of greens fees. Tee time restrictions vary based on the plan selected. Cart fees required based on time/day of play.

- **Tier I** - Ages 35-75 - No Tee time restrictions
- **Tier II** - Ages 35-75 - Tee times available during the week anytime and on weekends/holidays after noon
- **Intermediate** – Under age 35 – No tee time restrictions
- **Junior** – Under age 21 – tee times available weekdays anytime and weekends after 2pm. Juniors that are accompanied by an immediate adult family Member may play at the same times as the adult Member. Juniors may also play outside the prescribed guidelines with the permission of the Director of Golf and the payment of a walking fee.
- **Senior** – Age 60+ Tee times available Mon – Thurs (except on outing days) Fridays before 1pm and weekends and holidays after 1pm with a surcharge.
- **Super Senior** – Age 75+ Tee times available weekdays anytime and weekends after Noon
- **Club II** - Tee times available weekdays anytime and weekends after Noon. Must be a Full Member at an authorized GAP Club.

Limited/Casual Golf Memberships

All limited/casual golf Memberships allow for play on the course based on the number of rounds in the designated plan. Limited/Casual Golf Members may play during the week anytime and on weekends and holidays after 1pm. All play requires the payment of a Social Member cart fee.

- **Talamore and Applecross residents** – Allows for 6x per year per household
- **Non-Resident Tier II and Tier III Members** – Allows for 12 rounds of golf annually
- **Club II Limited** – Allows for 6 or 24 rounds of golf based on plan selection

The Talamore Golf Resort & Mid South Club have a separate Membership Offering for its residents. More information is available through our NC Real Estate office or through the NC Club's General Manager.

• **Are there Initiation Fees, Membership Deposits or Bonds**

- Full Golf Memberships require a Membership Deposit.
- Initiation fees are required for Social/Limited Golf Memberships
- Resident based Membership at Talamore Country Club and Applecross Country Club requires a Transfer fee when the home is sold.
- There are no Bonds.

- ***Is the Membership Deposit or Initiation Fee refundable?***

Yes, if the Membership Deposit is paid in full upon signing up the Membership Deposit becomes refundable. If the deposit is paid through one of our long term payment plans the Member must remain active until the full amount of the Membership Deposit is paid before the amount paid becomes refundable per the terms and conditions in the Membership Offering. Initiation Fees for Sports or Social Membership are non-refundable. See the Membership Director for more details on the Club payment plans.

- ***Why do Talamore and Applecross offer 2 tiers of Full Membership?***

Weekend and holiday mornings are prime golf times. We believe strongly that a Club should limit the amount of Members who have access to those tee times.

- ***Are the amenities optional for Full Golf Members?***

Yes. Full Members have an option to add pool, tennis and use of the fitness center on an annual basis for an individual or family.

- ***Are Single and Family rates available?***

Yes. The Club offers different dues rates for single Members and for family Members for many of its Membership programs.

- ***What are the current guest rates and how many may each Member bring at one time?***

Applecross's & Talamore's guest rates vary from \$50 - \$125 depending on season, day of week and accompanied vs. unaccompanied status. Please contact the Pro Shop to check current rates.

- ***How far in advance can Members make tee times?***

Full Golf Members may make tee times up to 14 days in advance & Social / Sports Members may make tee times up to 7 days in advance. Tee times for our Members at the Talamore Golf Resort are made at the time of accommodations booking. Tee times may be made online at www.TalamoreFamily.com.

- ***Are there any tee time restrictions for spouses?***

NO. Talamore and Applecross are among the few private Country Clubs which does NOT discriminate tee time privileges for spouses. Spouse golfers receive the same tee time access as the primary golfer named on the Membership.

- ***Are clinics offered for beginner golfers?***

Yes, Talamore and Applecross offers clinic and instruction throughout the season with PGA professionals on staff.

- ***Is private instruction available?***

At Applecross and Talamore, we have PGA staff professionals available for private golf instruction. At Talamore, year round instruction opportunities are available in our state-of-the-art teaching center under the guidance of our Director of Instruction, Lou Guzzi. Information about the Lou Guzzi Golf Academy is available at www.louguzzi.com. At Applecross, private and group golf instruction is available with PGA Professional Eric MacCluen and his staff. New for 2011 is Applecross' indoor/outdoor teaching center.

- ***Is club fitting, club repair and lessons available for Applecross Members?***

Yes, club fitting, club repair and lessons are all offered through our experienced professional staff. Please contact our golf shop for additional information.

- *What type of practice options do Applecross Members have to choose from?*

- *Does Talamore and Applecross offer Members of other private Clubs an affordable way to join Applecross as a second Club?*

Yes. Talamore and Applecross have a unique way for Members of other approved private country clubs and GAP Clubs (Golf Association of Philadelphia) to join Talamore and Applecross as a second Club. Club II Membership does not require an Initiation Fee or Membership Bond.

- *What type of Member events are planned for the Golf Members?*

Each of the Talamore Clubs have over 30 events annually for its Golf Members. Events are planned by the Club in conjunction with a committee of Members and are very diverse. There are separate men's and ladies events, couples events, events for the family, parent and child, Member Guests, stag days and more.

Additionally there are over 30 social events each year at each of the Clubs.

A slate of interclub golf events and activities are planned to bring the whole Talamore family closer together!

- *When are the golf shop and range open?*

The Range and practice facilities are open year round weather permitting.

The Golf Shop – In season the Golf Shop is open from dawn to dusk, weather permitting. In the Off Season, the Golf Shop is open on days when course is available for play.

AMENITY & SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP QUESTIONS

• *Are Non-Resident Social Memberships offered?*

Yes. There are three tiers of Non Resident Social Membership.

- **Tier I** offers use of the pool, tennis and fitness center.
- **Tier II** is the same as Tier I, only it adds use of the golf course 12 times annually.
- **Tier III** is considered a Casual Golf Membership which allows use of the golf course 12 times annually.

Each Non-Resident Social Membership offers access to the Club's regular dining areas including the Applecross Grille, Findlay's at Talamore, Oak Terrace Patio and Talamore's Club 19 as well as invites to all Club social functions.

• *What amenities are offered at Talamore and Applecross?*

• *Are there personal trainers available in the fitness center?*

Personal trainers available upon request. We also run classes such as Pilates, Yoga and Aerobics throughout the year.

• *How many life guards are on duty during pool hours?*

For our outdoor pools in PA, a lifeguard is on duty during peak pool hours. For our indoor pool at Applecross a lifeguard is available during family designated times on the weekends when the outdoor pool is not otherwise open. In NC at the Talamore Golf Resort, there are no lifeguards on duty.

• *What are the hours for the pool and fitness center?*

Pool – 12pm till 6pm on Mondays & 10am to 8pm Tuesday thru Sunday from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Talamore and Applecross are some of the only pools to be open the first two weeks in June full time and has extended hours from 10-8 on Tuesdays – Sundays.

Fitness Centers – open daily from 5am until 10pm

• *Can Members bring guests to the pool? Is there any charge?*

Yes, Members may bring guests to the pool. Weekday, weekend and holiday rates apply. The Club does limit the number of guests per day at the pool and also limits the number of times a guest may come to the pool during the season.

- ***Are tennis programs offered?***

Yes. The Club has a tennis pro that offers lessons and clinics for the Members.

- ***Are Range plans available for Social Members?***
